

Dry Eye Syndrome

Dry Eye Syndrome is caused by a chronic lack of sufficient lubrication and moisture on the surface of the eye.

Signs of Dry Eye Syndrome:

- Blurry vision
- Excessive watering (tearing)
- Red eves
- Problems wearing contact lenses
- Fatigued eyes
- Irritation from windy conditions
- Scratchy/gritty feeling
- Sensitivity to light

Causes of Dry Eye Syndrome:

- Deficiency of tear producing glands Aqueous Deficient Dry Eye Syndrome
- Deficiency of oil layer in tear film Lipid Deficient Dry Eye Syndrome
- Environmental factors (dust, etc.)
- Heavy computer/digital device use
- Prolonged contact lens wear
- Medications (antihistamines, BC, etc)/ Health conditions (diabetes, Sjogren's)
- Hormonal fluctuations (especially in women)
- Smoking
- LASIK

Management/treatment of Dry Eye Syndrome:

- Artificial Tears see attached page for complete listing
- Eat a healthy diet rich in Omega 3 Fatty Acids or take an Omega 3 supplement
- Hydrate and humidify drink water and consider using a humidifier
- Avoid environmental factors such as dust, sand, electric fans, etc.
- Check medications and consider alternatives
- Ask your eye doctor about other treatments such as <u>punctal (collagen) plugs</u> or <u>Cyclosporine (Restasis)</u>
